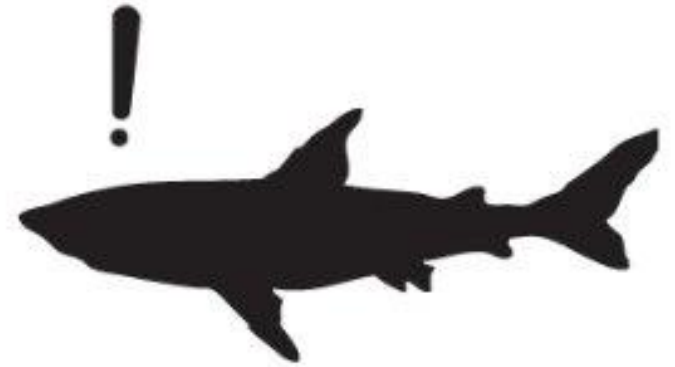
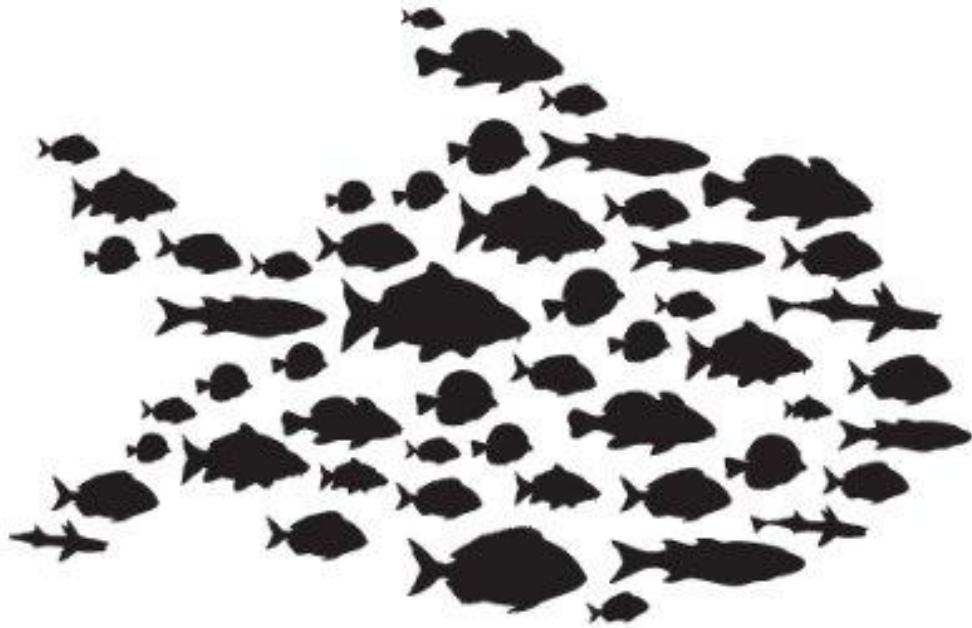
- To ensure robust procedures are in place to educate the pupils in how to stay safe
