## Summer Reading Challenge

The theme this year is **Animal Agents**. The illustrations for the challenge are by **Tony Ross**, the award winning artist behind the *Horrid Henry* series.

The Animal Agents feature a variety of clever creatures, specially trained to use their skills and natural instincts to unravel mysteries!

To take part in the Challenge, all children will need to do is sign up at their nearest library. They will be given a special collector's folder and, as they borrow and read at least six library books, they will receive Animal Agent stickers and prizes! All of this is free!
