Punctuality

Can we remind parents/ carers that it is your responsibility to ensure that your child arrives on time for school every day. At our school, children are expected to arrive in school by 8.50am and the side gate is locked at 8.55am. Pupils arriving after this time must enter school by the main entrance and be signed in by an adult where their name and reason for lateness will be recorded. "Running late" or "overslept" are not acceptable reasons for lateness. The pupil will be marked as late in the register and this will be recorded in their individual attendance report. Attendance registers are monitored regularly and persistent latecomers are noted. You may receive a request from the Headteacher to discuss your child's late arrival at school if this is a recurring problem.

Regularly arriving late at school can be embarrassing for your child and doesn't help them start the school day in the best way. We would appreciate your co-operation in helping your child to develop good personal organisational habits by getting to school on time every day .
