Christmas Jumper Day

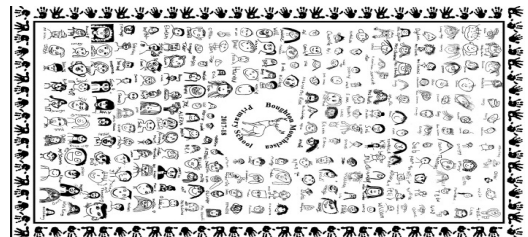
