## Punctuality



Thank you to all the parents and carers who make it to school on time every day, with the children getting into class by 8.50am. It really helps the children to get their school day off to a good start if they are not rushing in at the last minute. We have noticed however that as we lock the side gate at 8.55am, this may be causing some confusion about what time is acceptable for children to arrive at school. As a result, we will start locking the side gate at **8.50am** every day, at which time pupils should be in class ready to learn. Any latecomers will need to be signed in at the school office and will be marked as late in the register. This change will start from Monday 4<sup>th</sup> February to give you time to make any necessary changes to your morning routine. Thank you for your co-operation.

## School Traffic Monitoring



We are still receiving reports that some parents and carers are still not showing due consideration and attention when dropping their children off in the morning, despite repeated requests from us and the occasional presence of the Community Support Officer.
