Class 6	Nathaniel E-T.	For great writing about the Victorians

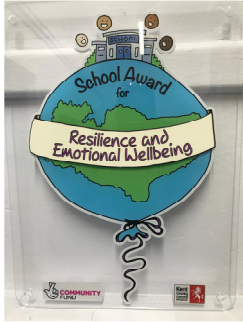
The Great Water Aid Splash Challenge
