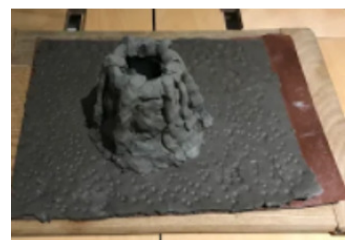
Class 3 made volcanoes as part of their Rocks, Relics and Rumbles topic and are going to make them erupt. Art & Design and Science combined!
