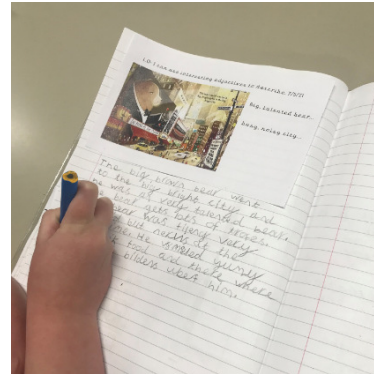
Class R have made an obstacle course.



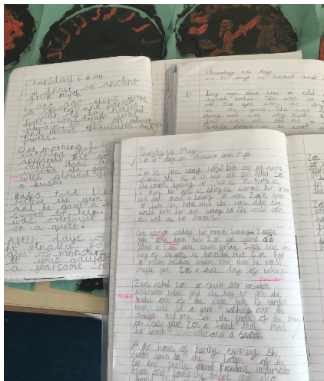
Class 1 have been practising their drawing skills.



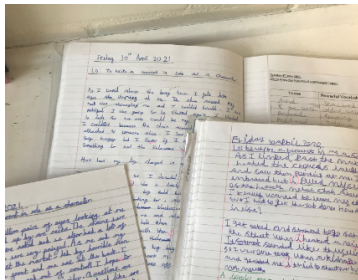
Class 2 have been writing about The Bear and The Piano



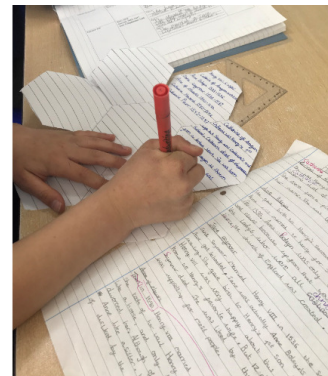
Class 3 have made Greek plates and written Greek myths
